Construction of Chandernagore Flyover

Chandernagore is not well connected to the National Highway (NH-2) commonly known as Delhi Road, running nearby the city, the age old Grand Trunk Road has become highly congested. The total length of the flyover with approach road is 3.96 Kms. running from Chandernagore Kalupukur Main Road to Nabagram Ashram Math via Subhashpally (North), Sankarabati, Bhushunara, Khalisani Monshatala, Bilkuli with a total land acquirement of 12.39 Acers involving a land cost of Rs. 21.39 Crores for such acquirement. The Chandernagore Municipal Corporation have already acquired 11 Acers of land till date on behalf of the KMDA, the implementing agency of the project. The construction commenced on and from February, 2014 by the vendor Larsen & Toubro Limited (L&T) and is targeted to be completed within 31st December, 2015. The total project cost involved was previously estimated at the tune of Rs. 35.0937 Crores which may be revised at the present cost value. As per the work progress report submitted by the L&T seventy percent of the project work is completed till date.

Mayor felicitated highest scorers of Madhyamik Pariksha & Higher Secondary Exam. 2015 students from amongst the schools under Chandernagore Municipal Corporation Jurisdiction

1944 students appeared on M.P (S.E) 2015 conducted by WBBSE from 25 schools within the jurisdiction of this Corporation out of which 1792 students passed (rate of pass 92.18%). Highest scorer **Soumajit Ghogh** [Kaniailal Vidyamandir (Eng)], **Sejuti Mardanna** [Krishna Bhabini Nari Siksha Mandir] & **Arnab Banerjee** [Chandernagore Sri Aurobindo Vidyamandir] scored 661 each. Mayor felicitated them with flower bouquet on the date of publication of result i.e. on 22/05/2015.

830 students appeared on H.S Examination 2015 conducted by WBCHSE out of which 786 passed (rate of pass 94.69%). Highest scorers of Science, Arts & Commerce stream are **Ipsita Das** (475 out of 500) from Krishna Bhabini Nari Siksha Mandir, **Suparna Modak** (471 out of 500) from Krishna Bhabini Nari Siksha Mandir, **Rwittik Debnath** (458 out of 500) from Kaniailal Vidyamandir (Eng) respectively. Mayor was pleased to encourage and felicitate them with flower bouquet on the date of publication of result i.e. on 29/05/2015.

Constitution of the Board of Councillors

On 20th May, 2015 the first meeting of the newly elected Councillors (elected from the last Municipal General Election – 2015 held on 25.04.2015) of the Chandernagore Municipal Corporation (CMC) in the district of Hooghly was held at **Rabindra Bhavan, Chandernagore** as per notification of the Government of West Bengal, Municipal Affairs Department. The **Hon'ble Councillors of the 33 Wards/Constituencies of CMC** made and subscribed an oath or affirmation of their allegiance to the Constitution of India duly administered by the District Magistrate, Hooghly in the august presence of Sri Rabindranath Bhattacharjee, Hon'ble Minister-In-Charge, Statistics & Programme Implementation, Govt. of West Bengal, Dr. (Mrs.) Ratna De Nag, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Sri Ashok Kumar Shaw, Hon'ble MLA, Chandernagore and the Sub-Divisional Officer, Chandernagore to name a few. The total ceremonial programme was very efficiently conducted

by Sri Ujjal Sengupta, WBCS (Exe.), Commissioner, Chandernagore Municipal Corporation as per statutory provisions laid down in the West Bengal Municipal Corporation Act, 2006.

Sri Ram Chakraborty was unanimously re-elected as the **Mayor** of the heritage town of **Chandernagore** for the second time and **Sri Jayanta Das** as the **Chairman** of the newly formed Board. Also, **Smt. Sanghamitra Ghosh** was declared as the Hon'ble **Deputy Mayor of Chandernagore** by the Hon'ble Mayor. The said programme was completed after the administration of oath of secrecy of the Hon'ble Mayor and the Chairman as mandated by the statute.
